KNITTED PILLOW

(From Cover)

Materials:

- Yarn Bee® Twirl-Tastic, 8 oz (226 g) skeins of 14.8 yds (13.5 m):
 - Pink/Teal – 3 skeins
- US size 50 (25 mm) circular needles
- 18" x 18" pillow form

Gauge:

4 sts and 4 rows = 4" square

Measurements:

18" x 18"

Instructions:

Front:

- CO 13 sts.
 - **Row 1:** *K1, p1, rep from * to end of row.
 - **Rows 2-16:** Rep row 1.
- Fasten off, and weave in ends.

Back:

- CO 13 sts.
- **Row 1:** Knit.
- **Row 2:** Purl.
- **Rows 3-16:** Rep rows 1 and 2.

Finishing:

Fasten off, and weave in ends. Cover pillow on both sides, and sew sides together using same yarn.

KNITTED INFINITY SCARF

Because your style shouldn't end when summer does. This cowl is as simple as knit, purl, you-go-girl.

Glossary:

ch – chain
CO – cast on
dc – double crochet
hdc – half double crochet
k – knit
p – purl
rep – repeat
rnd – round
sc – single crochet
sk – skip
sl st – slip stitch
sp – space
st(s) – stitch(es)
WS – wrong side(s)



Materials:

- Yarn Bee® Sweet Shades, 3.5 oz (99 g) skeins of 23 yds (21 m):
 - Peacock – 3 skeins
- US size 19 (15 mm) knitting needles
- Darning needle

Gauge:

5 sts and 8 rows = 4" in pattern

Measurements:

32" around x 11" wide

Instructions:

- CO 13 sts.
- **Row 1:** *K1, p1, rep to last st, k1.

- Rep row 1 until work measures 32".
- Cast off all sts.

Finishing:

Sew short ends together using yarn tail and darning needle.



CROCHETED TOTE

The yarn we used to make this project is mostly acrylic, so the typical fuzzy yarn fibers are few. That means lots of toting without all the shedding.

Materials:

- Yarn Bee® Astounding, 3.5 oz (99 g) skeins of 43 yds (39 m):
 - Teal (A) – 3 skeins
 - Charcoal (B) – 2 skeins
 - Platinum (C) – 4 skeins
- Size N (10 mm) crochet hook
- Yarn needle

Gauge:

1 granny square = 8" x 8"

Measurements:

Approx. 16" x 18" (without handles)

Instructions:

Granny Square (make 8):

- **Rnd 1:** With A, make a magic ring, ch 3 (counts as first st here and throughout), dc into ring 11 times. Sl st to join. Fasten off. (12 sts)

- **Rnd 2:** Join B, ch 3, 1 dc in same st, 2 dc in each st around. Sl st to join. Fasten off. (24 sts)
- **Rnd 3:** Join C, ch 3, 1 dc in same st, *1 dc in next st, 1 hdc in next st, 1 sc in next st, 1 hdc in next st, 1 dc in next st, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next st. Rep from * 2 more times. 1 dc in next st, 1 hdc in next st, 1 sc in next st, 1 hdc in next st, 1 dc in next st, 2 dc in first st, ch 2, sl st to join. (36 sts)

Sl st 4 granny squares together to form front of tote. Join C in corner sp, ch 1 and work 2 sc in corner sp, *1 sc in next 9 sts, 1 dc in next 2 sts (where squares join), 1 sc in next 9 sts, 3 sc in next corner sp, rep from * 2 more times. 1 sc in next 9 sts, 1 dc in next 2 sts, 1 sc in next 9 sts. Sl st to join in first corner sp. Rep

for back of tote, using remaining 4 granny squares.

Finishing:

Place front of tote on top of back (WS together), sl st left side, bottom and right side together.

- **Rnd 1:** Join A in side seam st at top left, work 1 sc in every st around top of tote, sl st to join. Turn work.
- **Rnd 2:** Ch 1, 1 sc in next 5 sts, ch 35, sk next 14 sts, 1 sc in next 11 sts, ch 35, sk next 14 sts, 1 sc in next 5 sts, sl st to join. Turn work.
- **Rnd 3:** 1 sc in next 5 sts, 1 dc in each ch, 1 sc in next 11 sts, 1 dc in each ch, 1 sc in each st to end of row, sl st to join.



CROCHETED POCKET SCARF

A scarf that keeps your fingers warm? Hello, new cold-weather BFF.

Note: The pattern comes out long, so adjust the initial chain length to fit your size.

Materials:

- Yarn Bee® True Colors, 5 oz (141 g) skeins of 78 yds (71 m):
 - Gray (A) – 3 skeins
 - Mango (B) – 2 skeins
 - Yellow (C) – 2 skeins
- US size M/13 (9 mm) crochet hook
- Yarn needle

Gauge:

8 sts x 5 rows = 4" square in pattern

Measurements:

Approx. 107" x 6 1/2"

Instructions:

- With A, ch 200.
- **Row 1:** Dc into third ch, dc in each ch to end of row, turn work.
- **Row 2:** Ch 2, dc in each st to end of row. Fasten off.
- **Row 3:** With B, ch 3, dc into first dc, dc in each st to end of row, turn work.
- **Row 4:** Ch 2, dc into first st, dc into each st to end of row. Fasten off.
- **Rows 5-6:** With C, rep rows 3-4.
- **Rows 7-8:** With A, rep rows 3-4.
- Fasten off, and weave in ends.

Pockets (make two):

- With A, ch 14.
- **Row 1:** Sc into second ch, sc in each ch to end of row.
- **Rows 2-14:** Ch 1, sc in each st to end of row.
- **Row 15:** With C, ch 1, sc in each st to end of row. Fasten off.

Finishing:

With A, whipstitch one pocket to each end of scarf.
