FLOWER PENDANT:

- 3 – Metal flower charms
- Circle bezel, 1.5"
- Patterned paper
- Paper sealer
- Paintbrush
- Pen and scissors
- Inkpad and scissors
- Circle craft punch, 1.5"

PEACOCK PENDANT:

- Ornate rectangle bezel
- Glass glitter
- Mica fragments
- Peacock feather
- Scissors
- Paper sealer
- Paintbrush

TIPS & TRICKS

- **Less Is More:** Prepared resin hardens in 30–40 minutes, so don't mix more than you'll need for a single project.
- **Pop Star:** Blow on freshly mixed resin to eliminate bubbles—and if bubbles do make it to the surface intact, pop them with a pin.
- **Flat-Out Fun:** Be sure to work on a level, hard surface so your freshly poured resin cures to a perfectly flat finish.
