## Supplies:

- 1 – Shadow box, 10" x 20"
- Construction paper (3 sheets black, 3 sheets orange)
- White Paper (for bat template)
- Bat template (provided below)
- Adhesive foam squares, in black
- Black marker, fine tip
- Scissors, small



Bat template is actual size.

- 1.** Print out provided bat template.

Trace bats onto construction paper, then cut out. You'll need 25 black bats and 1 orange bat.



- 2.** To create a 3D look, gently fold wings inward as shown.



- 3.** Use adhesive foam squares to secure bats to inside of shadow box in rows of three, with the middle row of bats staggered as shown.



- 4.** When you've adhered 19 black bats, add the orange bat for an unexpected pop of color. Then adhere remaining black bats.
