

Argyle Annie Tunic



Tunic is worked flat with instarsia or stranded leopard pattern.



Odd-numbered rows knit, even rows purl

Tunic

Front/Back (make 2)

Ruffle

With Red and #6 needle, CO 184 stitches. Work three rows garter stitch starting with a WS row. Begin stockinette stitch, work 8 rows ending after a WS row.

Ruffle Decreases

Row 1: K2tog, *(K3, K2tog)* repeat * to * until 2 sts left, k2tog. 146 sts.

Row 2: Purl.


Row 3: K5, K2tog, K5, *(K2, K2tog)* repeat * to * until 14 sts left, K7, K2tog, K5. 114 sts.

Row 4: Purl.

Row 5: K1, *(K2, K2tog)* repeat * to * until 1 st left, K1. 86 sts.

Row 6: Purl.

Row 7: Knit.



Body

Change to Brown and Purl to end.

Argyle Pattern

Keeping each edge stitch (selvage) in Brown, begin 14-st Argyle Chart repeating 3 times across, end K1 (selvage in Brown). Continue as set through Row 15 of chart. Change to Brown and purl one row.

Change to Red and work in st st until piece measures 7" after a WS row.

Decrease 1 st each side, then every following 6th row 3 more times, 78 sts.

When piece measures 14" after a WS row, work 3 rows in seed stitch and BO in pattern.

Straps (make 2)

CO 8 sts. Work in seed stitch for 12", ending with a WS row.

K1, SKP, P, K, K2tog, P.

K, SKP, K2tog, K.

SKP, K2tog. BO.

Pocket (optional)

CO 21 sts. Work 4 rows stockinette st. Keeping background in Red, changing triangle to Brown and crosshatching in White, K3, work 14-st 14-st Argyle chart, repeat 1st stitch of Chart, end K3. Work as set to end of 15-row chart. Purl one row. Work 2 rows seed stitch and BO in pattern.

Finishing

Sew straps to inside of back starting 1" below top hem and 2¾" from side. Sew buttons through strap ends onto outside of front 2¾" from side. Sew pocket (optional) to front, see photo for placement. Sew side seams. Weave in all ends. Wash and block if desired.

Sizing: 5/6

Finished Measurements: Bust 28", Hip 32", Length 20"

Materials:

- 1 Love This Yarn Sport Solid 100% Acrylic 2.47oz/70g 230yds/210m 2 skeins #40 Red, 1 skein #10 White, 1 skein #230 Pink, 1 skein #160 Brown
- 32" length circular knitting needle, size US #6 (4mm)
- 2 1¼" buttons
- Tapestry needle

Gauge: 22 sts and 30 rows = 4" in st st on US #6 4mm needles


Glossary:

Argyle Annie Blanket



Blanket is worked modularly with each diamond knitted onto the previous.



Blanket

Note: The Diamonds are attached modularly, with all decreases lined up vertically. Stitches are picked up the "ditch" of the garter stitch edge (non-cast-on edge).

Make 3 Brown and 2 White Diamonds (Diamonds 1-5 on chart) as follows:


Diamonds

With yarn doubled and #10 needles, CO 40 sts.

Row 1 (WS): K20, PM, K20.

Row 2 (RS): K to 2 sts before marker, SKP, slip marker, K2tog, K to end.

Row 3 (WS): Knit.



Repeat rows 2 and 3 until 2 sts are left. K2tog, break yarn and pull through last loop to fasten off.

Using chart for color and order placement, attach Pink Diamonds (Diamonds 6-9) as follows:

Interior Diamonds

With RS facing, PU and K 20 sts along the left side of a diamond and PU and K 20 sts along the right side of the diamond. (Pick up stitches in the ditches of the garter stitches.) Work as for Diamonds above starting with Row 1.

Continue attaching Diamonds, *noting special instructions for the Edge Diamonds:*

Edge Diamonds, Right Side

Diamonds (10, 19, 28, 37): CO 20 sts, PU and K 20 sts along Diamond (6, 15, 24, 33), then continue as for Diamonds Row 1.

Edge Diamonds, Left Side

Diamonds (14, 23, 32, 41): PU & K 20 sts along Diamond (9, 18, 27, 36), CO 20 sts, then continue as for Diamonds Row 1.

Cross-Hatching

With crochet hook and two strands of Red held on the wrong side, (use photo for alignment) SC lines diagonally in the center of both directions of diamonds.

Finishing

Weave in all ends. Wash and block if desired.

Finished Measurements: 40" x 40"

Materials:

- I Love This Yarn Sport Solid 100% Acrylic 2.47oz/70g 230 yds/210m 1 skein #40 Red, 4 skeins #10 White, 6 skeins #230 Pink, 4 skeins #160 Brown
- Knitting needles, size US #10 (6mm)
- Tapestry needle
- Crochet hook, size US H/8 (5mm)

Gauge: 15 sts = 4" in garter st WITH YARN DOUBLED on US #10 6mm needles.


Glossary:

Argyle Annie Headband



Headband is worked flat.



□ Background ■ Diamonds ■ Crosses

Odd-numbered rows knit, even rows purl

Headband




Note: Can be worked stranded on the back or intarsia-style.

With Red and smaller needles, CO 136 sts. Work in K1P1 ribbing for 2 rows. (WS): Change to Brown and larger needle, K3, P to last 3 sts, attach Red and K3 sts, always keeping these last 3 sts in Red garter stitch. Row 1: K3 Red (edge sts), PM, in Brown K1, work 14sts of Row 1 of Argyle Chart (pink diamond), PM, in Brown K10sts, PM, work 14 sts of Row 1 of Argyle Chart repeating 7 times total (diamonds will start with pink and alternate with white), PM, in Brown K10. Row 2: K3 (edge sts), P7, work Row 2 of Argyle Chart across 7 repeats, P10, work Row 2 of Argyle Chart, P1fb, in Red K3 (edge sts). 137 sts.

Row 3: K3 Red, in Brown K1fb, work rest of row as set. 138 sts

Row 4: Work set through the 7 chart repeats of Row 4, then P3, K3, P4, work chart Row 4, P to last Brown st, P1fb, K3 Red.



Buttonhole (*see chart for placement*)

Row 5: K3 Red, in Brown K1fb, continue as set through 14 sts of chart row 5, K5, BO 1 st, attach second strand of Brown, K3, work as set through end of row.

Rows 6-8: Work as set, keeping stitch before and after buttonhole in garter stitch.

Row 9: K3 Red, in Brown SSK, K to marker, work as set through end of row.

Row 10: Work as set to last marker, P to last 2 Brown sts, P2tog, K3 Red.

Row 11: Work as set to second marker, K5, CO 1 st, K4, work as set for rest of row.

Rows 12-15: Work as set through end of chart.

WS: With Brown, Purl to last 3 stitches (discarding all other colors from chart), K3 red. Change to smaller needles and Red, K1 P1 for 2 rows. BO loosely in pattern.

Finishing

Weave in all ends. Sew on button on the opposite end from buttonhole. Wash and block if desired.

Sizing: Child size 5-9 years

Finished Measurements: 24" x 2 3/4"

Materials:

- I Love This Yarn Sport Solid 100% Acrylic 2.47oz/70g 230yds/210m #40 Red, #10 White, #230 Pink, #160 Brown, less than 1 skein of each color.
- Knitting needle, size US #5 (3.75mm)
- Knitting needle, size US #6 (4mm)
- 1 1/4" buttons
- Stitch markers
- Tapestry needle


Gauge: 22 sts / 30 rows = 4" in st st on US #6 4mm needles

Glossary:

- St st Stockinette Stitch, knit on right side, purl on wrong side
- RS Right side (public side of work)
- WS Wrong side
- CO Cast on
- BO Bind off
- P1fb Purl 1 front and back (increase)
- K1fb Knit 1 front and back (increase)
- P2tog Purl two stitches together (decrease)
- SSK Slip 1 knitwise, slip 1 knitwise, return to LH needle and knit both together through back loops (decrease)
- PM Place marker
- Garter Stitch Knit on both sides of fabric

Jungle Jane Tunic

Tunic is worked flat with intarsia or stranded leopard pattern.



Odd-numbered rows knit, even rows purl

Tunic

Front/Back (make 2)

Ruffle

With Brown and #6 needle, CO 184 stitches. Work three rows garter stitch starting with a WS row. Begin stockinette stitch, work 8 rows ending after a WS row.

Ruffle Decreases

Row 1: K2tog, *(K3, K2tog)* repeat * to * until 2 sts left, k2tog. 146 sts.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: K5, K2tog, K5, *(K2, K2tog)* repeat * to * until 14 sts left, K7, K2tog, K5. 114 sts.

Row 4: Purl.

Row 5: K1, *(K2, K2tog)* repeat * to * until 1 st left, K1. 86 sts.

Row 6: Purl.

Row 7: Knit.

Row 8: Purl.


Change to Black and work 2 rows in stockinette.

Body

Change to Cream and work in st st until piece measures 7" after a WS row.

Decrease 1 st each side, then every following 6th row 3 more times, 78 sts.

When piece measures 10" after a WS row, change to black and work 2 rows stockinette stitch.



Leopard Pattern

Keeping each edge stitch (selvage) in Cream, begin 19-st Leopard Chart repeating 4 times across, end K1 (selvage in Cream). Continue as set through Row 18 of chart. Change to Black and work 3 rows of garter stitch. BO all sts loosely.

Straps (make 2, knit lengthwise)

CO 70 sts in Brown. Working in garter stitch: Knit 2 rows. K to 1 st before end, Kfb. Knit. Repeat previous 2 rows 2 times more. Knit 2 rows. K to 3 sts before end, K2tog, K1. Knit. Repeat previous 2 rows 2 times more. BO all stitches loosely.

Finishing

Sew straps to inside of back starting 1" below top hem and 2 3/4" from side. Sew buttons through strap ends onto outside of front 2 3/4" in from side. Sew side seams. Weave in all ends. Wash and block if desired.

Sizing: 5/6

Finished Measurements: Bust 28", Hip 32", Length 20"

Materials:

- I Love This yarn Sport Solid 100% Acrylic 2.47oz/70g 230 yds/210m
- 2 skeins #25 Cream, 1 skein #30 Black, 1 skein #160 Brown
- 32" length circular knitting needle, size US #6 (4mm)
- 2 1/4" buttons
- Tapestry needle


Gauge: 22 sts and 30 rows = 4" in st st on US #6 4mm needles

Glossary:

- St st Stockinette Stitch, knit on right side, purl on wrong side
- RS Right side (public side of work)
- WS Wrong side
- Garter Stitch Knit every row
- CO Cast on
- BO Bind off
- K2tog Knit two stitches together
- Kfb Knit into the front and the back of a single stitch

Jungle Jane Blanket

Blanket is worked flat with yarn doubled in instarsia or stranded leopard pattern, then the border is picked up around the edges and worked in the round with an I-cord bindoff.



Odd-numbered rows knit, even rows purl

Blanket

Note: All stitches of blanket are worked with yarn doubled, i.e. two strands of the same color yarn make up each stitch.

With two strands of Black and #10½ needle, CO 131 stitches. Work 2 rows stockinette stitch.

Bottom Leopard

Keeping first 3 sts and last 3 sts in Black, begin working 25-st Leopard Chart at Row 1, repeating 5 times across. Work 20 rows of chart.

Side Leopard

Row 1: Work 3 sts Black, work Row 1 of 25-st Leopard Chart, work 75 sts Black, work Row 1 of 25-st Leopard Chart, work 3 sts Black.

Row 2: Work 3 sts Black, work Row 2 of 25-st Leopard Chart, work 75 sts Black, work Row 2 of 25-st Leopard Chart, work 3 sts Black.

Row 3: Work 3 sts Black, work Row 3 of 25-st Leopard Chart, work 3 sts Black, work 69 sts Cream, work 3 sts Black, work Row 3 of 25-st

Leopard Chart, work 3 sts Black. Continue as set through rest of rows of chart. Repeat as set through 1 more vertical repeat of chart, ending on Row 18.

Row 19: Work 3 sts Black, work Row 19 of 25-st Leopard Chart, work 75 sts Black, work Row 19 of 25-st Leopard Chart, work 3 sts Black.

Row 20 of 25-st Leopard Chart, work 3 sts Black.

Top Leopard

Keeping first 3 sts and last 3 sts in Black, begin working 25-st Leopard Chart at Row 1, repeating 5 times across sts. Work 20 rows of chart. Work 2 rows Black.

Border


With size #10 circular needle and Cream, K 131 stitches, PM, PU and knit 84 sts, PM, PU and K 131 stitches, PM, PU and knit 84 sts, PM.

Row 1: Purl one round.

Row 2: *Kfb, K to last stitch before marker, Kfb, slip marker* repeat * to * to end of round. Repeat these two rows until border measures 7" or desired size, ending after a knit row. Change to Brown and work 3-st I-cord bindoff or other bindoff of your choice.

Finishing

Weave in all ends. Wash and block if desired.



Row 20: Work 3 sts Black, work Row 20 of 25-st Leopard Chart, work 75 sts Black, work

Finished Measurements: 40" x 45"

Materials:

- I Love This Yarn® Sport Solid (100% Acrylic 2.5oz/70g 230yds/210m)
- 10 skeins #25 Cream, 4 skeins #30 Black, 4 skeins #160 Brown
- 32" circular knitting needle, size US #10½ (6.5mm)
- 32" circular knitting needle, size US #10 (6mm)
- Stitch markers
- Tapestry needle

Gauge: 16 sts and 20 rows = 4" in st WITH YARN DOUBLED on US #10½ (6.5mm) needles



Hat is worked flat.

Odd-numbered rows knit, even rows purl

Hat

Note: Hat is worked flat then seamed.

With Brown, CO 104 sts. Work in K1P1 ribbing for $\frac{3}{4}$ ".

(RS): Change to Black and knit 2 rows in stockinette stitch.

(RS): Change to Cream, K1 (selvedge st), and begin working 19-st Leopard Chart at Row 1, repeating 5 times across, then repeat stitches 13–19 again. Continue as set through last row of chart, in Cream K1 (selvedge st).

Change to Black, K1, SSK, K to last 3 stitches, K2tog, K1. 102 sts.

Purl next row.

Change to Cream and work until piece measures $5\frac{1}{2}$ ", placing markers after stitch 1, 26, 51, 76, 101.

Begin Crown Decreases

Row 1: K1, *[K2tog, K to 2 sts before next marker, SSK]* repeat * to * 3 times more, end K1. 94 sts.

Row 2: Purl.

Repeat these two rows 6 more times. 46 sts.

Row 1: K1, *[K2tog, K to 2 sts before next marker, SSK]* repeat * to * 3 times more, end K1. 38 sts.

P2, *[P2tog]TBL, P to 2 sts before next marker, P2tog]* repeat * to * 3 times more, end P1. 30 sts.

Repeat these two rows once more. 14 sts.

K1, *[remove marker, K3tog]* repeat * to * 3 more times, end K1. 6 sts.

Break yarn leaving a 20" tail. Using a tapestry needle, draw snugly through remaining stitches, then use to sew seam from crown to ribbing.

Finishing

Weave in all ends. Wash and block if desired.

Sizing: Child size 5–9 years

Finished Measurements: 17" head circumference

Materials:

- I Love This Yarn Sport Solid 100% Acrylic 2.47oz/70g 230 yds/210m #25 Cream, #30 Black, #160 Brown, less than 1 skein of each color
- Knitting needle, size US #6 (4mm)
- Stitch markers
- Tapestry needle

Gauge: 22 sts / 30 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch on US #6 4mm needles
