# Supplies

- Stackable wood crosses (large and medium)
- Small mosaic cross
- Scrapbook paper
- Decoupage medium
- Decoupage medium roller tool
- Moss
- Paint
- Craft knife
- Cutting mat
- Sponge brushes
- Hot glue gun/glue sticks
- Paint cup
- Scissors



1



Paint sides of large and medium crosses.

2



Brush a thin layer of decoupage medium onto medium cross. Carefully lay scrapbook paper on top of cross, and use roller tool to smooth. Let dry.

3



Place cross facedown on cutting mat, and use craft knife to trim away excess scrapbook paper.

4



Hot glue medium cross to center of large cross.

5

Cover exposed portion of large cross with moss, securing with hot glue as you work.



6



Trim away excess moss.

7



Hot glue small mosaic cross to center of medium cross.

Now display—or even give away—your faux naturel creation!
