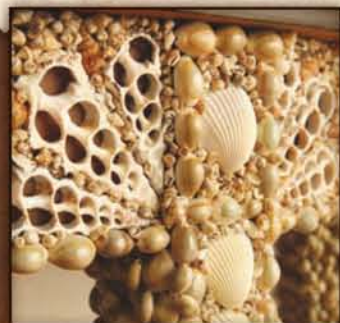


sea legs | On the wall or on the table, seashells turn anything into object d'art. For a simple, but dramatic display, fill a frame with a trio of graceful starfish, mounted onto burlap backing for texture. For this designer-worthy side table, we took "artfully arranged" to a whole new level. We decided to use each variety of shell as its own design element, rather than a random approach. The result is sleek, distinctive and truly stunning!



high tide | A shell-embellished bistro table is simply divine. Add a faux pearl-in-shell finial (wood knob, painted and glittered) for a hint of unexpected whimsy.

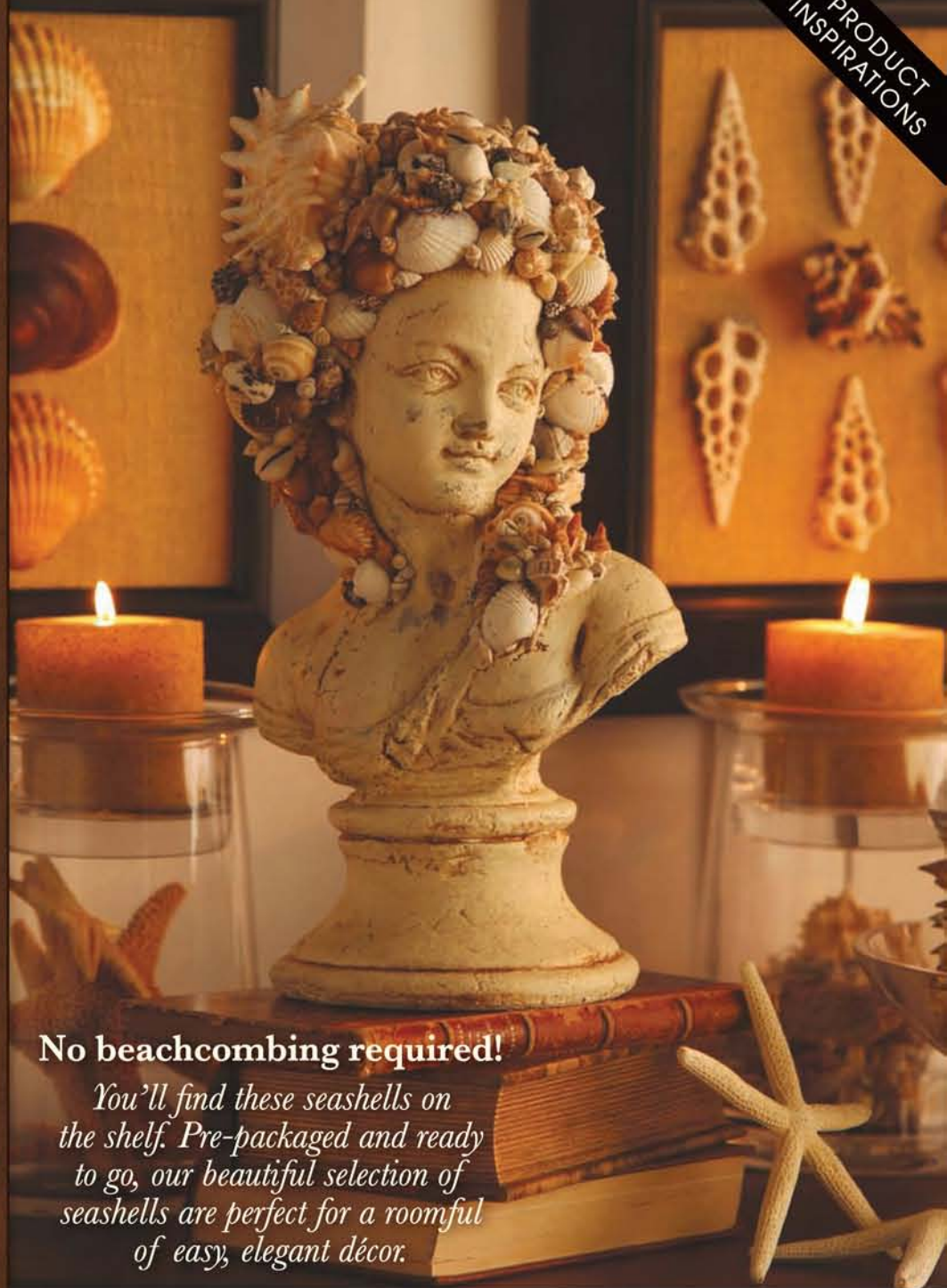


starlight | Thanks to their natural beauty, you need only to tuck a few starfish inside a glass candleholder to make an elegant design statement.



shell garland | Need a fancy fix for a boring chandelier? Drape it with these tiny, shiny shells. Garland is sold pre-strung, and the petite shells have a natural luminous shimmer in candlelight!


beach wreath | Take your shell collection out of the drawer and glue them onto a wreath! Add netting and cotton cording to complete the seaside look.

Designer Mantle DIY

Here's how to do it yourself using a hot glue gun and a bucket of seashells! Use the largest shells to create a focal point for the design. Then artfully arrange the medium-sized shells all around mantel using the unique shapes and coloring to your design advantage. Use the smaller shells to fill in the gaps and balance out your overall design. Voilà!
