MASON JAR CENTERPIECES

Time: 20 Minutes | Level: Beginner

SUPPLIES:

- XL Glue Dots®
- Craft Glue Dots®
- Mini Glue Dots®
- Mason iars and lids (quart, pint and ½ pint sizes)
 - Mini evergreen trees (various sizes)
- Small plastic deer (optional)
- Perfect pearls or glitter
- Artificial snow
- Twine
- Tweezers
- Cardstock (various colors)
- Die cut machine (snowflake, poinsettia, deer silhouette)

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Place XL Glue Dots® on the bottom of the larger tree and place firmly in the largest
- 2. Place Craft Glue Dots® on the bottom of the smaller tree and place firmly in a smaller mason jar. Tweezers may assist in this task.
- Create deer silhouette from brown card stock (or use optional plastic deer). Adhere to bottom of jar with Mini Glue Dots®.
- Sprinkle glitter or perfect pearls over the trees to add a shimmer.
- Add enough artificial snow to the jars to cover the bottom. Some will stick to the trees as well
- 6. Wrap twine around mason jar lids and tie in a bow.

TO MAKE SNOWFLAKES:

- Using a snowflake die cut, cut a front and back per snowflake from glittered paper.
- Adhere back-to-back with Mini Glue Dots® to create individual snowflake.
- 3. Adhere the snowflakes to the inside of the iar with Mini Glue Dots®. Repeat steps 4-6.

TO MAKE POINSETTIAS:

- 1. Cut poinsettia pieces from red and green cardstock using the die cut machine.
- Place brad through the center of the poinsettia flower and leaves.
- 3. Place Mini Glue Dots® on the brad and adhere the poinsettia to the inside of the jar. Repeat steps 4-6.





UPCYCLED GIFT BAG

Time: 30 Minutes | Level: Beginner









CHIPPLIES.

- Ultra-Thin Glue Dots®
- Pop Up Glue Dots®
- Mini Glue Dots®
- Green gift bag
- Twine

- Patterned paper
- Christmas-themed stickers
- Buttons, rhinestones, gemstones
- Border punch
- Small stapler

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Measure the width of the bag and cut the patterned paper to the same width. Measure the height of the bag and add $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " to the top and bottom of the height.
- 2. Using border punch, make a decorative border pattern on the top and bottom of the naner
- 3. String two pieces of twine across the bottom portion of the paper and adhere ends to the paper with Mini Glue Dots®. Add staple accents in an X over the ends of the twine and Mini Glue Dots®.
- 4. Add a sentiment tag sticker using Pop Up Glue Dots® and add the leaf sticker beside the tag using Mini Glue Dots®.
- 5. Thread twine through red button and adhere to top of tag with Ultra Thin Glue Dots®. 6. Add rhinestones and other embellishments to the top of the paper.
- 7. Adhere the embellished paper onto one side of the bag using Ultra-Thin Glue Dots®.
- 8. Cut a piece of patterned paper that matches the original size of the embellished paper.
- 9. Add a punched border to both top and bottom edges and adhere the paper onto the backside of the bag with Ultra-Thin Glue Dots®

NOEL BANNER

Time: 60 Minutes | Level: Intermediate

SUPPLIES:

- Micro Glue Dots®
- Mini Glue Dots®
- Ultra-Thin Glue Dots®
- 1" Glue Lines®
- XL Glue Dots®
- XXL Glue Dots®
- Canvas
- Brown cardstock
- Burlap

- · Chipboard letters: N.E. L and snowflake (in place of the 0)
 - Patterned paper
- Border punch
- 1" circle punch
- Scissors
- Green paint
- Embellishments (pearls, buttons, eyelets, ribbon, paper flowers, etc.)

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Cut patterned paper into four 9" x 7" banner rectangles.
- 2. Using the border punch, punch a decorative border around the sides and bottom.
- 3. Cut four banner rectangles slightly smaller than 9"x 7" using a complementary piece of patterned paper.
- 4. Layer the smaller banner pieces on top of the bigger banner pieces using Glue Dots®.
- 5. Roughly cut four 4" x 5" pieces of canvas.
- 6. Roughly cut four 4" x 6" pieces of burlap and layer offset onto canvas pieces with Glue Dots®.
- 7. Once the burlap and canvas are layered, offset and adhere the canvas to the banner using 1" Glue Lines®.
- 8. Cut triangle shapes from canvas and patterned paper, making sure the patterned paper triangles are smaller than the canvas. 9. Using 1" Glue Lines®, adhere the patterned paper triangle on top of the canvas
- triangle and adhere triangles to banners. 10. Punch a 1" circle from patterned paper and adhere it to the front of the rosette with
- XL Glue Dots®. 11. Paint letters green and let dry.
- 12. Add gold glitter for dimension with 1" Glue Lines® around edges and sides.
- 13. Use 1" Glue Lines® to adhere finished letters to banner pieces.
- 14. Use Mini Glue Dots®, Ultra-Thin Glue Dots® and Micro Glue Dots® to add embellishments to banner pieces.
- 15. Punch a hole in each corner on the top of banners. Add decorative eyelets and thread ribbon to tie banner pieces together.







TO MAKE ROSETTES:

- 1. Cut a strip of patterned cardstock to 12" x 1 ½" and score every ½".
- 2. Fold accordion style and adhere the ends together with a 1" Glue Line® to create a circle.
- 3. Peel off the liner of an XL Glue Dot® and press the center of the rosette onto the adhesive.

CHIPBOARD ORNAMENTS

Time: 60 Minutes | Level: Intermediate









SUPPLIES:

- Ultra-Thin Glue Dots®
- Mini Glue Dots®
- Pop Up Glue Dots®
- XL Glue Dots®
- Square chipboard shape (3 34" x 3 34")
- Rectangle chipboard shape (3 1/3" x 1 1/3")
- Circle chipboard shape (3 1/4" diameter)
- Patterned paper
- Sentiment stickers
 - 1" circle punch
- Red twine
- Gemstones
- Border punch

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Cover both sides of chipboard shapes with patterned paper. Secure using Ultra-Thin
- 2. Trim excess and distress the edges for an aged look.
- Punch a circle and adhere it to top of the rosette with XL Glue Dots®.
- 4. Peel off the back liner on the XL Glue Dot® and press the rosette onto the ornament.
- 5. Use Mini Glue Dots® to add embellishments.
- 6. Punch a hole on the top of the ornaments, thread twine through and tie to create loop.

TO MAKE PAPER ROSETTES:

- 1. Punch out a decorative edge on one edge of a 12" x 1 ½" strip of paper.
- Score the paper every ½", fold accordion style and adhere the ends together with a 1" Glue Line® to create a circle.
- 3. Peel off the liner of XL Glue Dot® and press the center of the rosette onto the adhesive.
