SIMPLE

Size: 60" x 68"

Materials:

- I Love This Yarn® (shown in Terra Cotta, Sungold and Burnt Pumpkin), 7 oz. skeins of 355 yds.

Color 1 (A) – 6 skeins

Color 2 (B) – 4 skeins

Color 3 (C) – 5 skeins

 Medium

- Yarn needle

Knitting needles:

Size 15 (10 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

Gauge:

1 ripple = 7"

12 rows = 4 ½"

Abbreviations:

K – knit

K2tog – knit together

Rep – repeat

Yo – yarn over

Directions:

Note: Pattern is worked holding two strands of yarn together.

With A, cast on 162 sts.

Pattern Rows:

Row 1 (right side): Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: *(K2tog) 3 times, (yo, k1) 6 times, (k2tog) 3 times, rep from * across.

Row 4: Knit.

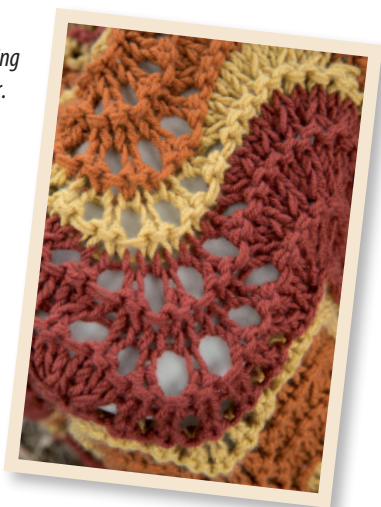
Rep Pattern Rows twice more. Attach B.

With B, rep Pattern Rows once. Attach C.

With C, rep Pattern Rows 3 times. Attach B.

With B, rep Pattern Rows once. Attach A.

Working in color sequence established, continue until afghan measures 68" long or desired length, ending with A. Weave in ends.
