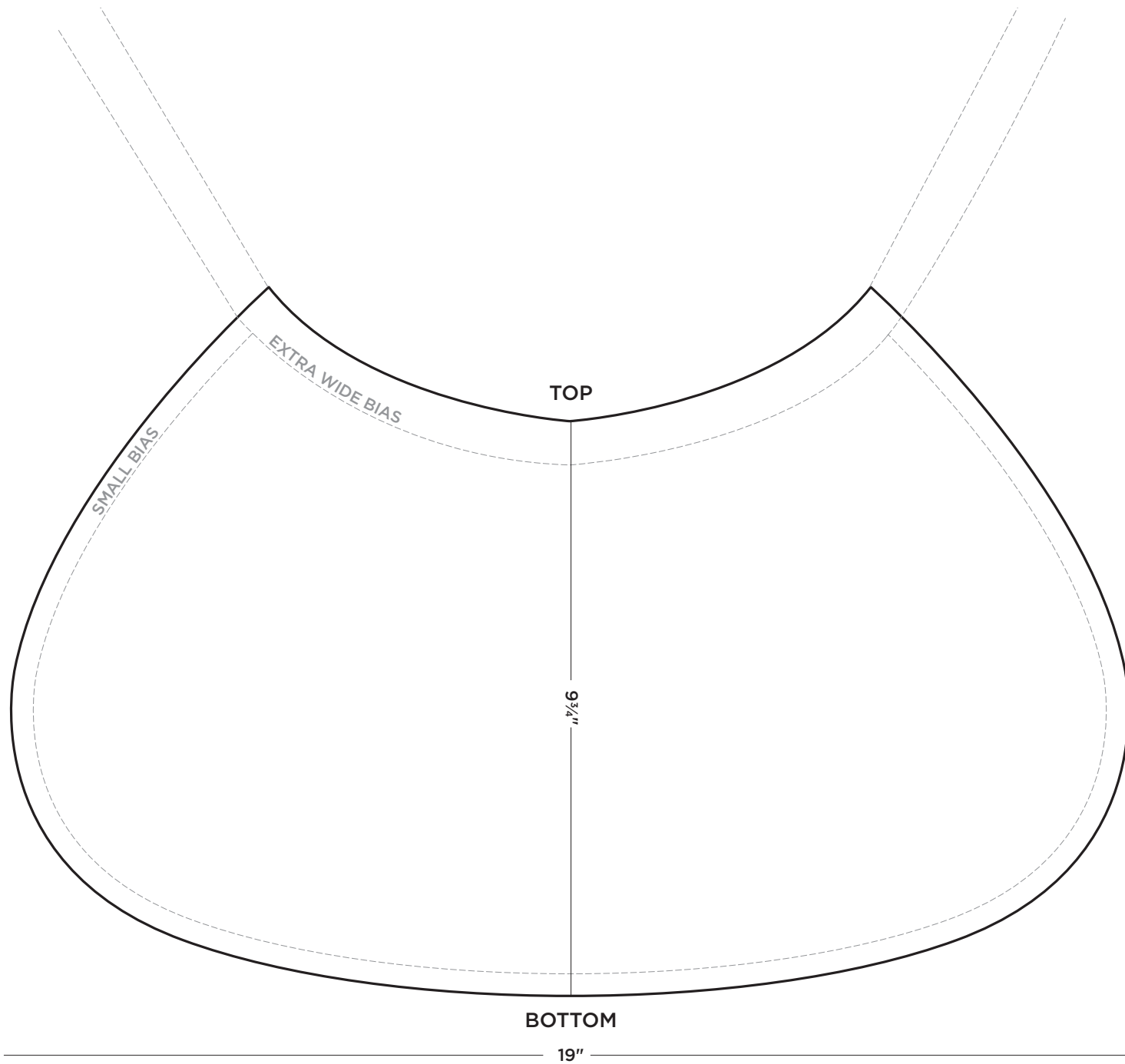

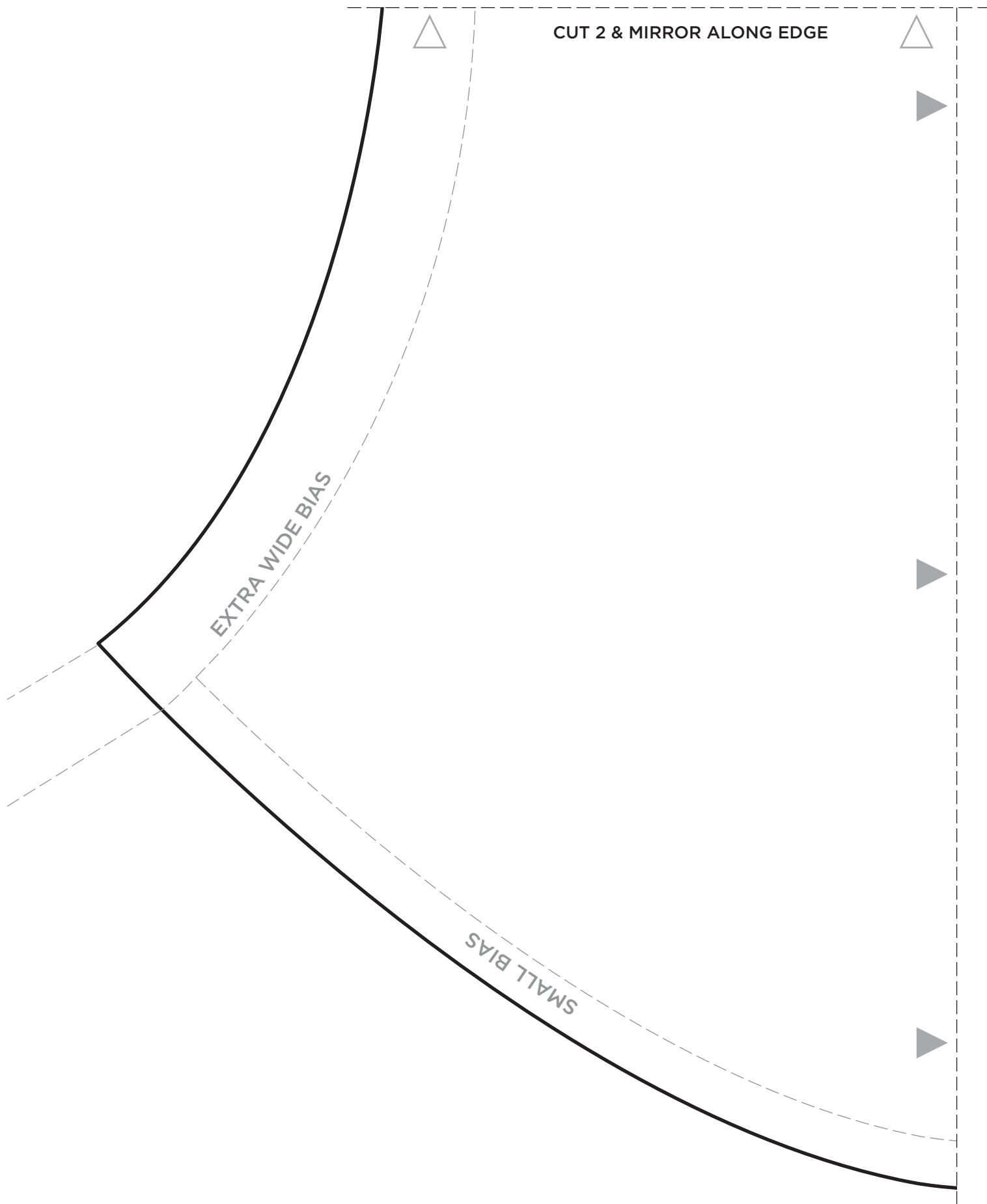


CUT 2 VINYL

(2 of 3)

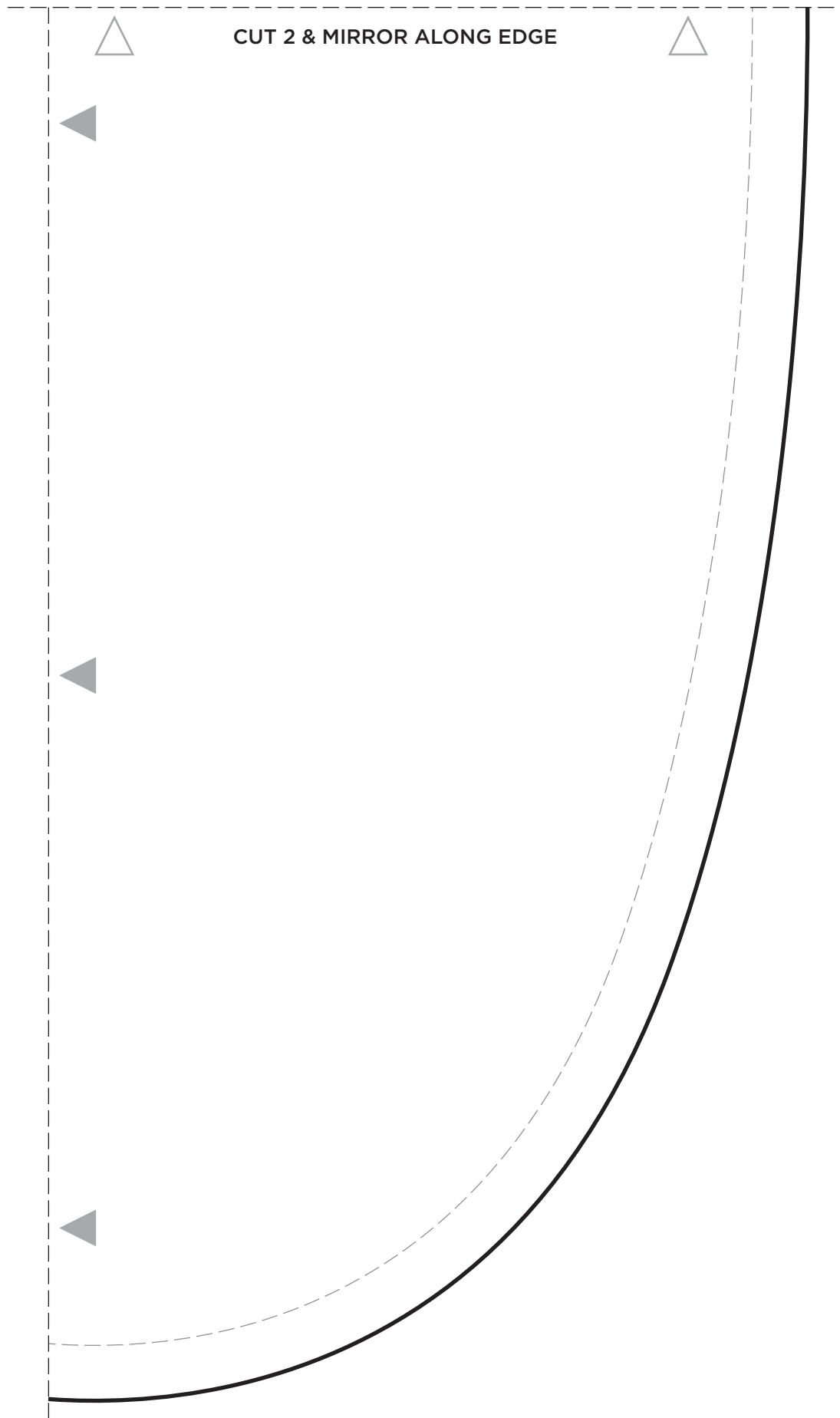
For full size template, cut out all pieces
Align arrow ends and tape template together

(3 of 3)

For full size template, cut out all pieces
Align arrow ends and tape template together



Supplies



VINYL FABRIC + BIAS TAPE = SIMPLE DIY FACE SHIELD

Note: We used double-fold bias tape, but you can use single-fold or even make your own.

SUPPLIES:

- Vinyl fabric – ½ yd.
- Double-fold bias tape
- Extra-wide double-fold bias tape (for straps)

STEPS:

1. Cut vinyl fabric according to template (found at hobbylobby.com).

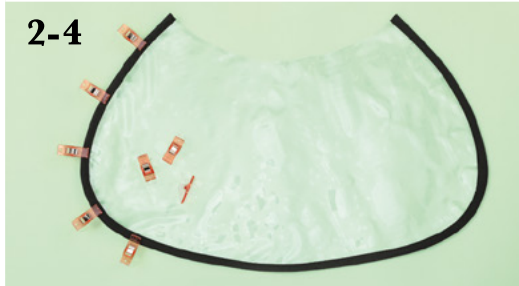
Note: Use one or two layers, depending on thickness of vinyl.

2. Sew double-fold bias tape around sides and bottom.
3. Cut 50" of extra-wide double-fold bias tape.
4. Mark top of vinyl at center and mark center of bias tape.
5. Align both marks and sew bias tape to vinyl.
6. Sew remaining bias tape together (aligning edges) to make straps.
