BANDANA SCARF

intermediate

ABBREVIATIONS:

ch = chain

ch sp = chain space

dc = double crochet

hdc = half double crochet

k = knit

lp = loop

rep = repeat

sc = single crochet

sk = skip

sl st = slip stitch

sp(s) = space(s)

st(s) = stitch(es)tc = triple crochet

MEASUREMENTS: 34" x 20"

MATERIALS:

- · Yarn Bee[®] Sugarwheel[™], 7 oz (198 g) skeins of 355 yds (325 m): All-A-Swirl – 1 skein
- · US Size J (6 mm) crochet hook
- · Small wood beads 38
- · Wood button 1
- · Yarn needle
- · Scissors

GAUGE:

13 sts and 8 rows =4" square

The best part about handmade is the customization factor, so don't hold back! Add beads that speak to your style—from wooden to pearl and everything in between.



INSTRUCTIONS:

String 38 beads (push these down as you go to keep them out of the way), then ch 4, sl st to first ch to form a lp, turn. If you choose to not incorporate beads into your scarf, you can ch 1 in place of the bead.

Row 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc and 1 ch), 3 dc into lp, ch 3, 3 dc into lp (this will be referred to as the corner sp throughout), ch 1, 1 dc into lp, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc and 1 ch), 3 dc into first ch sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in corner sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1, dc) last ch sp, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as first dc and 1 ch), 3 dc into first ch sp, ch 1, 3 dc into next ch sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in corner sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1, dc) in last ch sp, turn.

Rows 4-18: Ch 3 (counts as first dc and 1 ch), 3 dc in first sp, ch 1, *3 dc into next sp, ch 1 rep from * to corner sp, in corner sp (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc), **ch 1, 3 dc into next ch sp, rep from ** to last ch sp, and in the same sp ch 1, 1 dc, turn.

Row 19: Ch 1, 1 sc in next 73 sts, (1 sc, ch 1, 1 sc) in corner sp, 1 sc in next 73 sts, turn.

Row 20: Ch 1, 1 sc in same st, 1 sc in next st, *sk 3 sts, 7 tc in next st, sk 3 sts, 1 sc into next st*, rep from * to * 8 more times, (ch 3, sk 1 st, 1 sc into next st), rep from * to * 9 times, finish with 1 sc into last st, turn.

Row 21: Ch 3 (counts as 1 tc), 1 tc in next st,* ch 2, sk 1 st, 1 dc into next st, 1 sc into next st, place bead, sk 1 st, 1 sc in next st, 1 dc into next st, ch 2, sk 1 st, 1 tc in next st*, rep from * to * 8 times, (ch 1, 1 tc, ch 1

Row 22: Ch 2 (counts as 1 dc), 1 dc in next st, *3 dc in ch sp, ch 1, 1 dc in next sp (where bead is), ch 1, 3 dc in next ch sp, sk 1 st*, rep from * to * 8 more times, 2 dc in each of next 5 ch sps, sk 1 st, rep from * to * 8 times, 3 dc in ch sp, ch 1, 1 dc in next sp (where bead is), ch 1, 3 dc in next ch sp, 1 dc in last 2 sts.

Row 23: Ch 1, 1 sc in next 4 sts, *ch 3, sk 2 sts, 1 sc in next st*, rep from * to * 25 more times, ch 4, sk 2 sts, 1 sc in next st, ch 4, sk 2 sts, 1 sc in next st, ch 4, sk 2 sts, 1 sc in next st, ch 4, sk 2 sts, 1 sc in next st, ch 4, sk 2 sts, 1 sc in next st, rep from * to * 26 times, 1 sc in last 3 sts, turn.

Row 24: Ch 1, 1 sc in next 4 sts, *ch 3, sk ch sp, 1 sc in sc st from previous round*, rep from * to * 25 more times, ch 4, sk ch sp, 1 sc in

next st, ch 4, sk ch sp, 1 sc in next 2 sts, ch 4, sk ch sp, 1 sc in next st, ch 4, sk ch sp, 1 sc in next st, rep from * to * 26 times, 1 sc in next 3 sts, turn.

Row 25: Ch 3 (counts as 1 tc), 1 tc in next 3 sts, *ch 3, sk ch sp, 1 tc in next sc*, rep from * to * 24 more times, ch 3, sk ch sp, 1 dc in next st, ch 4, sk ch sp, 1 sc in next st, ch 2, sk ch sp, 3 tc in next st, ch 2, 3 tc in next st, ch 2, sk ch sp, 1 sc in next st, ch 4, sk ch sp, 1 dc in next st, rep from * to * 26 times, 1 tc in next 3 sts, turn.

Row 26: Ch 1, 1 sc in next 4 sts, *3 sc in ch sp*, rep from * to * 25 more times, 4 sc in next ch sp, 3 sc in next ch sp, 1 sc in next 3 sts, (1 sc, ch 2, 1 sc) in corner sp, 1 sc in next 3 sts, 3 sc in next ch sp, 4 sc in next ch sp, rep from * to * 26 times, 1 sc in next 4 sts, turn.

Row 27: Ch 2 (counts as 1 dc), 1 dc in next 10 sts, place bead, sk 1 st, *1 dc in next 8 sts, place bead, sk 1 st*, rep from * to * 8 more times, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in corner sp, place bead, sk 1 st, rep from * to * 9 times, finish with 1 dc in next 11 sts, turn.

Row 28: Ch 1, 1 sc in same st, *sk 2 sts, 7 tc in next st, sk 2 sts, 1 sc in next st*, rep from * to * 14 more times, 1 sc in next 2 sts, 1 dc in next 2 sts, 7 tc in ch lp, 1 dc in next 2 sts, 1 sc in next 3 sts, rep * to * 15 times, turn.

Row 29: Ch 3 (counts as 1 tc), 1 dc in next st, 1 hdc in next st, 1 sc in next st, *(1 sc, ch 2, 1 sc) in next st, 1 sc in next 7 sts*, rep from * to * 13 more times, (1 sc, ch 2, 1 sc) in next st, 1 sc in next 11 sts, (1 sc, ch 2, 1 sc) in next st, 1 sc in next 11 sts, rep from * to * 14 times, (1 sc, ch 2, 1 sc) in next st, 1 hdc in next st, 1 dc in next st, 1 tc in last st, turn.

Row 30: Ch 1, 1 sc in next 5 sts, (1 sc, ch 2, 1 sc) in next |p, 1 sc in next 7 sts, *1 sc in next st, ch 3, 1 sc in next st, (1 sc, ch 3, 1 sc) in next |p, 1 sc in next st, ch 3, 1 sc in next 5 sts*, rep from * to * 12 more times, 1 sc in next st, ch 3, 1 sc in next st, ch 3, 1 sc in next st, (1 sc, ch 3, 1 sc) in next |p, 1 sc in next st, ch 3, 1 sc in next st, (1 sc, ch 3, 1 sc in next st, (1 sc, ch 3, 1 sc in next st, (1 sc, ch 3, 1 sc in next st, ch 3, 1 sc in next st, ch 3, 1 sc in next 2 sts, ch 3, 1 sc in next 8 sts, rep from * to * 14 times, 1 sc in next 2 sts, (1 sc, ch 2, 1 sc) in next |p, 1 sc in next 5 sts.

FINISHING:

Fasten off, and weave in ends. Attach wooden button to one end.

HOODED SCARF

beginner

ABBREVIATIONS:

CO = cast on

k = knit

n = purl

PM = place marker

rep = repeat

SM = slip marker

st(s) = stitch(es)

MEASUREMENTS:

12" x 29"

MATERIALS:

- Yarn Bee[®] Sugarwheel[™]
 7 oz (198 g) skeins of 355 yds (325 m): Cinnamon
 You There 2 skeins
- · US Size 10 circular knitting needles
- Stitch markers
- · Yarn needle

GAUGE:

15 sts and 20 rows =

4" square in stockinette



Here's a needle-art project that'll get you in the snow-angel spirit. The pattern includes a slouchy hood to keep those ears toasty no matter which coat you layer on top.

INSTRUCTIONS:

CO 49 sts.

Rows 1-10: K1, *p1, k1, rep from * to end of row.

Row 11: (K1, p1) 4 times, k1, PM, k to last 9 sts, PM, (k1, p1) 4 times, k1.

Row 12: (K1, p1) 4 times, k1, SM, p to marker, SM, (k1, p1) 4 times, k1. Rep rows 11 and 12 until work measures 20" from cast-on edge.

HOOD:

Next row: (K1, p1) 4 times, k1, SM, k to end of row.

Following row: P to marker, SM, (k1, p1) 4 times, k1.

Rep previous two rows until section measures 18".

Rep rows 11 and 12 until work measures 58" from cast-on edge.

Fasten off, and weave in ends.

FINISHING:

Fold in half, and match up edges without decorative border. Pin in place. Sew hood section together along edge. Add tassel if desired.

INFINITY SCARF

beginner

ABBREVIATIONS:

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

hk = hook

lp = loop

rep = repeat

sc = single crochet

sk = skip

st(s) = stitch(es)

MATERIALS:

· Yarn Bee[®] Sugarwheel[™], 7 oz (198 g) skeins of 355 vds (325 m): Parisian Macaroon – 1 skein

· US Size I/9 crochet hook

· Yarn needle

MEASUREMENTS:

Approx. 7 ½" wide x

GAUGE:

2 ½ sts and 2 rows

The shell-stitched pattern keeps it classic. And the color-blocked palette makes it fresh. So what's missing? Not much, really. Just a few hours of making and so many days of enjoying.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Foundation Row: Ch 40

Row 1: 2 dc in third ch from hk (making half shell), sk next 2 ch, 1 sc in next ch, ch 5, sk next 5 ch, 1 sc in next ch, sk next 2 ch, 5 dc in next ch (making shell), sk next 2 ch, 1 sc in next ch, ch 5, sk next 5 ch, 1 sc in next ch, sk next 2 ch, 5 dc in next ch (making shell), sk next 2 ch, 1 sc in next ch, ch 5, sk next 5 ch, 1 sc in next ch, 3 dc in last ch (making half shell), turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 5, 1 sc through next ch-5 lp, ch 5, 1 sc in third dc of next shell, ch 5, 1 sc through next ch-5 lp, ch 5, 1 sc in third dc of next shell, ch 5, 1 sc through next ch-5 lp, ch 5, sc in the top of turning ch, turn.

Row 3: Ch 5, 1 sc through next ch-5 lp, 5 dc in next sc (making shell), 1 sc through next ch-5 lp, ch 5, 1 sc through next ch-5 lp, 5 dc in next sc (making shell), 1 sc through next ch-5 lp, ch 5, 1 sc through next ch-5 lp, 5 dc in next sc (making shell), 1 sc through next ch-5 lp, ch 2, 1 dc in last sc, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, 1 sc in first dc, ch 5, 1 sc in third dc of next shell, ch 5, 1 sc through next ch-5 lp, ch 5, 1 sc in third dc of next shell, ch 5, 1 sc through next ch-5 lp, ch 5, sc in third ch of turning ch, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3 and then 2 dc in first st (making half shell), 1 sc through next ch-5 lp, ch 5, 1 sc through next ch-5 lp, 5 dc into next sc (making shell), 1 sc through next ch-5 lp, ch 5, 1 sc through next ch-5 lp, 5 dc into next sc (making shell), 1 sc through next ch-5 lp, ch 5, 1 sc through next ch-5 lp, 3 dc into last sc (making half shell), turn.

Rows 6-101: Rep rows 2-5. Rows 102-103: Rep rows 2 & 3.

FINISHING:

Make sure scarf is not twisted when joining bottom and top edges. Top edge of row 103 should fit into bottom edge of row 1 so that when joined together, shell and diamond pattern will continue. Stitch one or two stitches into third dc of each shell, and join it through center of each ch-5 loop. Stitch one or two stitches into each of side edges. Weave in ends.
