Amongst the needlepoint supplies you'll find the perfect base for a minimalist wreath—hello, embroidery hoop! Hot glue floral picks (eucalyptus, ranunculus and berries onto the hoop, add a gold-painted chipboard greeting, and combine it with a wood sign from Crafts.











1 Country Cluster

The trick to using relatively short floral picks with a tall vase? The filler! We put newspaper in the bottom of this galvanized metal container, stacked floral foam on top, and arranged away. **Tip:** Use thinner picks and sprays to give your bouguet nice height.

Pick a Stitch

Charming? Unexpected? That's our kind of wall hanging Base: rows of half-double crochet and back loop half-double crochet stitches. Flowers: DIY'd floral-pick bouquets attached with hot glue (or try slipping their stems through the crocheting for interchangeability!).

3 All Together Now

When the floral picks are in full bloom, the monogram letter (Home Accents) comes pre-painted and the hangable wooden plaque (Crafts) just needs a quick striping of paint, you'll have custom decor in no time flat.
