SKILL LEVEL: Easy/Beginner

SIZE: One size

MEASUREMENTS: Approx. 56" x 28"
laying open flat

GAUGE: 12 sts and 17 rows = 2.5"

MATERIALS:

- Yarn Bee® Chloe, 3.5 oz (100 g)
skeins of 270 yds (247 m):
 - Arctic Spruce (A) – 2 skeins
 - Pine Forest (B) – 3 skeins

- US size 8 (5 mm) knitting needles
- Knitting counter

Special Stitch(es):

Wavy stitch:

Row 1: K2tog, k2tog, k, yo, k, yo, k, yo, k,
yo, k, k2tog, k2tog.

Row 2: P.

Row 3: K.

Row 4: K.

INSTRUCTIONS:

BACK

With A, CO 150 sts. Turn.

Rows 1-9: K150. Turn.

Row 10: K8, p2, *wavy stitch, rep from *
nine more times, p2, k8. Turn.

Row 11: K10, p130, k10. Turn.

Row 12: K8, p2, k130, p2, k8. Turn.

Row 13: K150. Turn.

Row 14-69 : Rep rows 10-12 fourteen
more times. Join B.

Row 70 (RS): K8, p2, k130, p2, k8. Turn.

Row 71 (WS): K10, p130, k10. Turn.

Row 72-160: Rep rows 70-71 forty-five
more times or until work measures
approximately 24" from CO. Turn.

Row 161 (WS): K10, p59, k12, p59, k10.
Turn.

Row 162 (RS): K8, p2, k130, p2, k8. Turn.

Row 163-168: Rep rows 161-162 three
more times.

Row 169 (WS): K10, p59, k4, inc 4, k4,
p59, k10. Turn.
From row 170 to the end, the piece will
be knitted separately.

RIGHT SIDE

Row 170 (RS): K8, p2, k67. Turn.

Row 171 (WS): K8, p59, k10. Turn.

Row 172-287: Rep rows 170-171 until
work measures 45" from CO. Turn.

Row 288 (RS): K8, p2, k67. Turn.
Join A.

Row 289 (WS): K77. Turn.

Row 290: K8, p2, *wavy stitch, rep from
* three more times, k2tog, k2tog, k, yo,

k, yo, k9. Turn.

Row 291: K8, p59, k10. Turn.

Row 292: K8, p2, k67. Turn.

Row 293: K77. Turn.

Row 294-349: Rep rows 290-293
fourteen more times.

Rows 350-359: K77. Turn.
BO all sts.

LEFT SIDE

Join B on first st.

Row 170 (RS): K67, p2, k8. Turn.

Row 171 (WS): K10, p59, k8. Turn.

Row 172-287: Rep rows 170-171 until
work measures approximately 45"
from CO. Turn.

Row 288 (RS): K67, p2, k8. Turn.
Join A.

Row 289 (WS): K77. Turn.

Row 290: K9, yo, k, yo, k, k2tog, k2tog,
*wavy stitch, rep from * three more
times, p2, k8. Turn.

Row 291: K10, p59, k8. Turn.

Row 292: K67, p2, k8. Turn.

Row 293: K77. Turn.

Row 294-349: Rep rows 290-293
fourteen more times.

Rows 350-359: K77. Turn.
BO all sts.

FINISHING:

Weave in ends.



Ear We Are

Toasty ears = happy heart. And what else makes us happy? The subtle gradient, from taupe to soft brown and back again, on this gorgeous cable-knit project. The color is called Bisque.

•3scb = 3-stitch cable back : SI 2 st(s) on cn, holding it at back. K1. SI 2, holding st back on kn. K2.

INSTRUCTIONS:

CO 35 sts.

Row 1:*K1, p1. Rep from *. Turn.

Row 2:*P1, k1. Rep from *. Turn.

Rows 3-10: Rep rows 1-2, turning each time.

Row 11: Rep row 1, inc 5 sts for total of 40 sts. Turn.

Row 12: P4, k3, p2, k6, p2, k6, p2, k6, p2, k3, p4. Turn.

Row 13: P3, k1, p3, k2, p6, k2, p6, k2, p6, k2, p3, k1, p3. Turn.

Row 14: P4, 4scf, 4scb, 4scf, 4scb, 4scf, 4scb, 4scf, 4scb, p4. Turn.

Row 15: P3, k2, p6, k2, p6, k2, p6, k2, p6, k2, p3. Turn.

Row 16: P5, 6scb, p2, 6scb, p2, 6scf, p2, 6scf, p5. Turn.

Row 17: P3, k2, p6, k2, p6, k2, p6, k2, p6, k2, p3. Turn.

Row 18: P5, k6, p2, k6, p2, k6, p2, k6, p5. Turn.

Row 19: P3, k2, p6, k2, p6, k2, p6, k2, p6, k2, p3. Turn.

Row 20: P5, 6scb, p2, 6scf, p2, 6scb, p2, 6scf, p5. Turn.

Row 21: P3, k2, p6, k2, p6, k2, p6, k2, p6, k2, p3. Turn.

Row 22: P4, 4scb, 4scf, 4scb, 4scf, 4scb, 4scf, 4scb, p4. Turn.

Row 23: P3, k1, p3, k2, p6, k2, p6, k2, p6, k2, p3, k1, p3. Turn.

Row 24: P4, k3, p2, 6scb, p2, 3scb, 3scf, p2, 6scf, p2, k3, p4. Turn.

Row 25-132: Rep rows 13-24 nine more times.

Row 133: Rep row 1, dec 5 sts.

Row 134-143: Rep row 2 – row 1 five more times.

BO all sts and weave in ends.

FINISHING:

Overlap first 10 rows with last 10 rows, sewing underneath on edge line. Hand sew three buttons.

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate/Advanced

SIZE: One size

MEASUREMENTS: Approx. 4.5" x 21"

GAUGE: 12 sts and 17 rows = 2.5"

MATERIALS:

•Yarn Bee® Chloe, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 270 yds (247 m):

-Bisque – 1 skein

•US size 8 (5 mm) knitting needles

SPECIAL STITCH(ES):

•6scf = 6-stitch cable front: SI 3 st(s) on cn, holding it at front. K3. SI 3, holding st back on kn. K3.

•6scb = 6-stitch cable back: SI 3 st(s) on cn, holding it at back. K3. SI 3, holding st back on kn. K3.

•4scf = 4-stitch cable front: SI 3 st(s) on cn, holding it at front. P1. SI 3, holding st back on kn. K3.

•4scb = 4-stitch cable back: SI 1 st on cn, holding it at back. K3. SI 1, holding st back on kn. P1.

•3scf = 3-stitch cable front: SI 1 st on cn, holding it at front. K2. SI 1, holding st back on kn. K1.



Have A Cowl

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

MEASUREMENTS: 15" x 12" (when folded in half and joined at ends) 30" x 12" (before folding in half)

GAUGE: 16 sts and 8 rows of dc = 4" square

MATERIALS:

- Yarn Bee® Chloe, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 270 yds (247 m):
-Carnation – 2 skeins
- US size H (5 mm) crochet hook

SPECIAL STITCH(ES):

Puff Stitch: *Yo, insert hk, pull up a lp (*6 times), 13 lps on hk, yo, pull through all 13 lps

When crocheting into a puff stitch row, you will crochet into each st and ch in the row.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Ch 121.

Row 1: Hdc in second ch from hk and each ch across. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, hdc in each st. Turn.

Row 3: Ch 2, puff st in second st, ch 1, sk 1 st, *puff st in next st, ch 1, sk 1 st, rep from * until last st, which will be puff st.

Let's talk about chic crocheted neckwear, the humble (but mighty) puff stitch and two skeins of self-stripping Chloe yarn. What's it all add up to? A project made in sweater-weather heaven.

Row 4: Ch 1, hdc in each st. Turn.

Rows 5-6: Ch 1, hdc in blo of each st. Turn.

Row 7: Ch 1, hdc in each st. Turn.

Rows 8-9: Ch 1, hdc in blo of each st. Turn.

Row 10: Ch 1, hdc in each st. Turn.

Row 11: Ch 2, puff st in second st, ch 1, sk 1 st, *puff st in next st, ch 1, sk 1 st, rep from * until last st, which will be puff st.

Row 12: Ch 1, hdc in each st. Turn.

Row 13: Ch 2, puff st in second st, ch 1, sk 1 st, *puff st in next st, ch 1, sk 1 st, rep from * until last st, which will be puff st.

Row 14: Ch 1, hdc in each st. Turn.

Row 15: Ch 2, dc in each st. Turn.

Row 16: Ch 1, hdc in blo of each st. Turn.

Row 17: Ch 2, dc in each st. Turn.

Row 18: Ch 1, hdc in blo of each st. Turn.

Row 19: Ch 2, puff st in second st, ch 1, sk 1 st, *puff st in next st, ch 1, sk 1 st, rep from * until last st, which will be puff st.

Row 20: Ch 1, hdc in each st. Turn.

Row 21: Ch 1, hdc in third lp of each st. Turn.

Row 22: Ch 2, dc in each st. Turn.

Row 23: Ch 1, hdc in third lp of each st. Turn.

Row 24: Ch 2, dc in each st. Turn.

Row 25: Ch 2, puff st in second st, ch 1, sk 1 st, *puff st in next st, ch 1, sk 1 st, rep from * until last st, which will be puff st.

Row 26: Rep row 2.

Row 27: Ch 2, puff st in second st, ch 1, sk 1 st, *puff st in next st, ch 1, sk 1 st, rep from * until last st, which will be puff st.

Row 28: Ch 1, hdc in each st. Turn.

Rows 29-30: Rep row 16.

Row 31: Ch 1, hdc in each st. Turn.

Rows 32-33: Ch 1, hdc in blo of each st. Turn.

Row 34: Ch 2, puff st in second st, ch 1, sk 1 st, *puff st in next st, ch 1, sk 1 st, rep from * until last st, which will be puff st.

Rows 35-36: Ch 1, hdc in each st. Turn.

FINISHING:

With RS tog, fold in half, placing short ends tog and matching up rows. Sl st evenly across. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Here's a one-skein project that's worth its weight in warm fuzzies. The puff stitch provides style and texture, Chloe yarn provides warmth (and ooh-la-la), and you provide DIY cred.

SKILL LEVEL: Easy

MEASUREMENTS: 9" x 11"

GAUGE: 16 sts and 8 rows of dc = 4" square

MATERIALS:

- Yarn Bee® Chloe, 3.5 oz (100 g) skeins of 270 yds (247 m):
 - Oats - 1 skein
- US size H (5 mm) crochet hook
- Yarn needle for sewing in ends

SPECIAL STITCH(ES):

Puff Stitch: *Yo, insert hk, pull up a lp (*6 times), 13 lps on hk, yo, pull through all 13 lps

INSTRUCTIONS:

BAND

Ch 8.

Row 1: Hdc in second ch from hk and each ch across. Turn (7 sts).

Rows 2-60: Ch 1, hdc in blo of each st across. Turn.

Fold piece in half and sl st short ends tog, creating a band. Flip band RS out to continue with hat portion.

MAIN HAT

*Join to beg ch at end of each rnd, which will not count as first st.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc evenly in each row around band. Sl st to join to beg ch. Turn.

Rnd 2 (WS): Ch 2, 1 dc in each st. Sl st to join. Turn.

Rnd 3 (RS): Ch 1, 1 hdc in blo of each st. Sl st to join. Turn.

Rnd 4 (WS): Ch 1, 1 hdc in each st. Sl st to join. Turn.

Rnd 5 (RS): Ch 1, 1 hdc in blo of each st. Sl st to join. Turn.



Who's That Hat

Rnd 6 (WS): Ch 2, puff st in first st, ch 1, sk 1, *puff stitch in next st, ch 1, sk. Rep from * around. Sl st to join. Turn.

Rnd 7 (RS): Ch 2, 1 dc in first puff st, 1 dc in next ch sp. *1 dc in next puff st, 1 dc in next ch sp. Rep from * around. Sl st to join.

Rnd 8 (WS): Ch 2, 1 dc in each st. Sl st to join. Turn.

Rnd 9 (RS): Ch 1, 1 hdc in blo of each st. Sl st to join. Turn.

Rnd 10 (WS): Ch 2, 1 dc in each st. Sl st to join. Turn.

Rnd 11 (RS): Ch 2, 1 dc in each st. Sl st to join. Turn.

Rnds 12-17: Rep rnds 6-11.

Rnds 18-21: Rep rnds 6-9.

Rnds 22-23: Ch 2, dc in first st, dc2tog, *dc in next st, dc2tog, rep from * around. Sl st to join.

FINISHING

Fasten off, leaving 10" tail for sewing around top. Weave tail through top sts and pull to gather closed. Fasten off and weave in ends.
